Each canoe usually has an overall general theme. Canoes are stained or painted. Some are very intricate with their designs. Canoes will be on a presentation stand so everyone can see the inside and outside. This stand will be a display designed to hold the canoe at a height of 2.5 to 4 feet below the canoe, giving ample viewing. There will be no sounds, lights, or canopies accompanying this portion of the event.
