

Driving Directions from the Airport

*Helpful tip: East is in the direction of the mountains.

To the Civil Engineering building:

When exiting the airport, take the Yale Blvd. exit. Drive north on Yale Blvd. to Central Ave. Yale will “T” on Central. Turn left (west) onto Central Ave. and take it to University Blvd. Turn right (north) onto University Blvd. The first stoplight on University is Martin Luther King Jr. Ave. At this intersection turn right (east) into the UNM main campus. Take an immediate right onto Redondo Dr. Tapy Hall, the building that houses the Civil Engineering Office, is directly behind the demolition site.

Visitor Parking:

Beginning November 28, 2005, and continuing through September 2007, construction on UNM’s new School of Architecture will close Stanford Drive from Central to Redondo, the loop road that runs around campus.

Visitors are asked to enter campus at:

- Yale and Central
- Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and University
- Las Lomas and University
- Lomas and Stanford or
- Campus and Girard

Drivers should drive clockwise around the campus. Signs directing traffic to the Cornell Parking Garage, bookstore, Popejoy Hall, Johnson Gym, and the Student Union Building will be posted.
