ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE OF FINE ARTS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.

NON-DEGREE STUDENTS do NOT use this application. You must file a UNM application for admission through the Office of Admissions. The requirements for admission are the same as those listed below, but the application and deadline are different. This application for admission may ONLY be used by students in University College or in a UNM degree-granting college (such as Arts & Sciences) for internal transfer.

Requirements for Admission

1. Completion of 26 credit hours of earned credit.
2. (a) A grade point average of at least 2.5 on all hours attempted, or
(b) A grade point average of at least 2.5 on the last 30 hours attempted.
3. Competency in English writing as demonstrated by:
(a) achieving a score of 29 or higher on the English section of the ACT; or a score of 650 SAT verbal; or
(b) completion of English 101 with a grade of C or better
4. Completion of 12 credit hours of course work in the major area.
5. **Art Studio, Art History, Media Arts, Music, Theatre and Dance majors: an interview with the department advisor.**
6. **Music and Music Education majors only:** Approval as a concentration in the appropriate instrument or voice for the degree Bachelor of Music or Bachelor of Music Education. This is demonstrated by completion of ApMus 102 or 120 and enrollment in ApMus 201, 219, or above.
7. **Dance majors only:** Pre-approved acceptance as a dance major. **You must attach a copy of your acceptance letter as a dance major.** This acceptance letter is contingent on passing the Dance Audition, which occurs each year on the last Saturday in January. If you cannot attend the audition, you must submit a video or DVD of you performing and pass a telephone interview with one of the dance faculty. Contact the Dance Office at (505)277-3660 for audition details.

How to Apply

1. Fill out the attached Application for Admission to the College of Fine Arts.
2. Request a current ADVISEMENT TRANSCRIPT (which shows courses and grades for ALL semesters you have completed) from the Records Office, room 250 in the Student Services Center. If you are a recent transfer to UNM from another university, you must also submit a copy of your UNM transfer evaluation. **PICK UP THE TRANSCRIPT FROM RECORDS AND ATTACH IT TO YOUR APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION.**
3. Return the completed application and transcript to the Fine Arts Advisement Center room 1103 in the Center for the Arts.
4. Art History/Art Studio majors schedule an appointment with Mickey McConnell, the Undergraduate Art Advisor, CA 1103, 277-4817. Media Arts majors call the Fine Arts Advisor, at 277-4817 to set up an appointment. Music majors see Keith Lemmons, the Music Advisor, CA 2107, 277-4905. Music Education applications will be sent to the Music Education Committee. Theatre majors see Denise Schulz, the Theatre Advisor, CG 107, 277-7326. Dance majors see Jennifer Predock-Linnell, the Dance Advisor, Carlisle Gym 105, 277-3606.
5. Within 1-3 weeks of submitting your application and your appointment (if required), you will be informed by mail of the decision on your admission. If you do not receive notice by mail, please come to the Fine Arts Advisement Center and ask about your status.

APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION FOR NEXT SEMESTER WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES THROUGH THE FINAL DAY OF CLASSES OF THE CURRENT SEMESTER.
