

# Four Generations of the Family of Kent Harry Williams

(Prepared by William M. Litchman)

## Explanation

Kent Harry Williams (1936-2010) was, for a short time, the husband of my sister, Ellen Francis Litchman (1937-2003). Their two lives are woven together even though their marriage lasted only a few months. They met at Baker University, Baldwin City, Kansas, where Ellen was studying English literature and Kent was studying liberal arts. I met Kent only once (Christmas, 1958) and was not impressed by him but my involvement with Ellen over the years has been intimate and difficult. She told me certain things about Kent and this study is the result of trying to get down to the real facts of his life and family, beginning only with what I was told by her. She said three things: 1) that his parents were Harry and Ann Williams, 2) that Kent had died in the mental wing of the Veterans Administration hospital in Kansas City, and 3) that he had attacked his mother and tried to kill her while on a flight to California. After this investigation, none of these assertions appear to be true.

The information presented here is the result of a study in March and April 2011 using on-line sources from a few trusted web sites. It is complete as far as it goes. The information supplied by Ellen led to searching for notices in *The Salina Journal* regarding the marriage of Ellen and Kent in 1958 and their divorce in 1962. From there, moving from one discovery to the next, this document has been constructed. All the information came from:

Only a few scattered dates and other items (a previously unknown child who died as a small infant in one family) were accepted from the undocumented web site "New FamilySearch" of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (<https://new.familysearch.org/>). These few items did not conflict with what has been found. I also obtained original birth and marriage certificates for Ellen from the Kansas state department of health and vital statistics in Topeka and her death certificate from the New Mexico state department of health and vital statistics in Santa Fe. All sources are given in the footnotes. Transcriptions and extractions of all source documents are given at the end of the report.

The report is in four parts: 1) the family of John W. Williams (four generations ending with Kent); 2) the family of James Cannon down to where his line joins the Williams line; 3) similarly for the family of Joseph Dowdey; and 4) George Doesken. All peripheral lines are followed to the present as far as possible. Current laws of privacy prevent personal information for living individuals to be easily found though a few living individuals are presented herein.

From this work, we now know that Kent's parents are John W and Angeline T (Dowdey) Williams, not Harry and Ann Williams. We also know that Kent was never in the military, so would never have had access to any Veterans' Hospital and couldn't have died in the mental wing of such an institution in Kansas City or anywhere else. Finally, the likelihood that Kent might have attacked his mother in an attempt to kill her on an aircraft would have certainly resulted in his incarceration and he would not have been living peacefully with her in Coeur d'Alene when she (and then he) died. These flights of imagination are typical of Ellen's mind.

# Part One

## The Family of John W. Williams

### First Generation

1. **John W. Williams** was born about 1817, Kentucky.<sup>1</sup> John married (1) **Julia Burgess**<sup>2</sup> about 1840, Missouri. Julia was born 12 Jan 1815,<sup>3</sup> Kentucky,<sup>4</sup> and died 22 Aug 1894, Jackson, Missouri, and is buried in the Blue Springs Cemetery, Blue Springs, Jackson, Missouri.<sup>5</sup> Julia and John were divorced soon after 1850 though she continued to live in Platte county with (mostly) her son James S. Williams.<sup>6</sup> Their known children are:

- + 2 M i. **William L. Williams** was born 18 Mar 1841, Platte, Missouri.
- + 3 M ii. **James S. Williams** was born Jan 1842, Platte, Missouri.
- 4 F iii. **John M. Williams** was born about 1848, Platte, Missouri.<sup>7</sup> In 1860 John is listed in the separate households of his mother and father. He reappears, still single, age 62, in the 1910 household of his brother James S Williams.<sup>8</sup>

John married (2) **Sarah Frances Owens** about 1857, Missouri.<sup>9</sup> Sarah was born 31 Oct 1838, Missouri,<sup>10</sup> died 4 Dec 1880, buried in Blue Springs Cemetery.<sup>11</sup> Both John and Sarah are deceased before 1900. Their children are:

Williams** was born Jan 1872, Platte, Missouri<sup>13</sup> and died 17 Aug 1955, Independence, Jackson, Missouri.<sup>14</sup> She married **Archie Lee Seymour** (born 2 Nov 1875, Grain Valley, died 9 Nov 1958, Independence, son of Joseph Seymour and Martha Humphries<sup>15</sup>) about 1913.<sup>16</sup> They had no issue.

## Second Generation

2. **William L. Williams** (John W Williams) was born 18 Mar 1841, Platte, Missouri.<sup>17</sup> In 1860, William is listed in the household of his father, John.<sup>18</sup> In 1870, he is in the household with his mother.<sup>19</sup> He died 28 Feb 1879, Missouri, and buried in New Market Cemetery.<sup>20</sup> He married **Sarah Frances Buchanan** (daughter of John Buchanan and Eleanor Ballinger) 8 Oct 1872, Platte, Missouri.<sup>21</sup> Sarah was born 3 Oct 1841, Clay, Missouri, died 23 Apr 1912, Platte, Buchanan, Missouri, and buried in Union Mill Cemetery, Edgerton, Platte, Missouri.<sup>22</sup> They had two children though a third may have died young:

3. **James S. Williams** (John W Williams) was born 21 Jan 1842, New Market, Platte, Missouri, died 28 Oct 1927, Green twp, Platte, Missouri.<sup>27</sup> He married Mrs. **Susan Loar** (born 6 Sep 1841, Kentucky, died 7 Jan 1925, Camden Point, Platte, Missouri, daughter of Thomas White and Polly Jones<sup>28</sup>) 19 Sep 1867, Buchanan, Missouri.<sup>29</sup> There are two older children in the 1870 James S Williams household, James H and (H)annible Williams.<sup>30</sup> In 1880, these two children appear as James H and Annible Loar<sup>31</sup> suggesting, along with the "Mrs" clue, that they are actually the children of Susan by a previous marriage (to Mr Loar).<sup>32</sup> In the death record for James H Loar, his parents are declared to be William Loar and Susan Elizabeth Loar.<sup>33</sup> No maiden name is given though her name matches her listing (Susan E Williams) in two censuses (1900,<sup>34</sup> 1910<sup>35</sup>).

Susan A Hickam married William Loar in Boone county, Missouri, 11 Nov 1852.<sup>36</sup> Susan Hickam, age 18, living in the 1850 household of George H and Minerva Hickam, is in Boone county, Missouri.<sup>37</sup> But there is a problem in simply concluding that Susan A Hickam is Mrs Susan Loar. First, there is a mismatch of middle initials for Susan as bride in 1852 and Susan as wife of James S Williams.

Another hint of trouble can be seen in the age of Susan, wife of James S Williams, given in her various census listings. She is age 30 in 1870,<sup>38</sup> 39 in 1880,<sup>39</sup> 59 in 1900 with a birth month of Sep 1841,<sup>40</sup> 68 in 1910,<sup>41</sup> and 78 in 1920.<sup>42</sup> These ages show a consistent calculated birth year of 1841 +/- 1 yr, with a declared birth month of Sep. Consistent, yes, but not anywhere close to the 1832 birth year for Susan A Hickam in 1850.<sup>43</sup> If Mrs Susan Loar was really born in 1841, she would have only turned 11 when William Loar married Susan A Hickam in Boone county.

Susan's parents are declared to be Thomas White and Polly Jones in her death record.<sup>44</sup> The informant is Maude Adams, Susan's married daughter. Thomas and Polly White are located in Mercer county, Virginia, with six children, including Susan, b 1840 in Virginia.<sup>45</sup> We can find this family in 1840,

1860 and 1870. The 1840 statistics<sup>46</sup> are correct for what we see in 1850 (including Harman, living next door in 1850) and the 1860 families<sup>47</sup> show that all four boys are married, the parents are alone, and the two daughters (Lucinda and Susan) are not present. The 1860 census entry for William and Susan Loar has not yet been found and it still remains a mystery whether there are two men named William Loar, both of whom married women named Susan or whether William Loar was widowed by the death of his first wife (Susan A Hickam) and subsequently married Susan Elizabeth White.<sup>48</sup> In either case, the first husband (William) of Mrs Susan Loar was certainly deceased or absent by 1867. James S. and Susan E. had children:

6. **Stonewall Jackson Williams** (John W.) was born 22 Sep 1863, Platte, Missouri. He died 11 Apr 1934, Concord, Clinton, Missouri. He was buried 13 Apr 1934, Blue Springs.<sup>54</sup> Stonewall married (1) **Martha Geneva Owings** 1 Feb 1898, Independence.<sup>55</sup> Martha was born, 12 Jun 1877 in Missouri.<sup>56</sup> She died on 18 Oct 1900 in Jackson, Missouri, and was buried in Blue Springs Cemetery.<sup>57</sup> Stonewall married (2) **Sarah Verda (---)**<sup>58</sup> about 1904, Missouri. Sarah was born 13 Feb 1882 in Missouri,<sup>59</sup> and died Oct 1978, Kansas City, Jackson, Missouri. She was buried in Blue Springs Cemetery,<sup>60</sup> and has a child:
