Introduction

My aunt Ev [Evelyn Lamont Thom(p)son], a school teacher from Denver, married my uncle Bob² [Robert William Morris] in Denver in 1927³ and after a stormy 15-year marriage, she filed suit for divorce in Denver in 1941.⁴ The divorce didn't come out of the blue as they tried separation for a short while in 1937.⁵ From comments made at the time, it appears that infidelity may have been at the root of the problem but it isn't very clear. Other comments by family members indicate that Ev was not the world's best housekeeper.⁶ Her family was not poor and had servants from time to time. Bob's family also had a live-in woman-of-all-work, Nettie Tolliver. Over the years since the divorce, I and the family lost touch with Aunt Ev and, since she disappeared from my experience while I was still very young, I've always wondered whatever happened to her.⁷

Recently, while looking for other things, I discovered an entry in the *California Death Index* for Evelyn Lamont Bachofer who died in San Francisco in 1981.⁸ The name combination of Evelyn and Lamont in this index record plus the facts that her SSN was issued in Colorado⁹ and that her mother's maiden name is Kemper is strong circumstantial evidence that this is the right person. The name Bachofer has been a significant name in Salina, Kansas, the town in which Bob Morris' sister [my mother] was a resident for many years.

The questions which are raised are fairly simple: What happened to her over the years from 1942 to 1981? Did she return to teaching or did she work in some other profession? Who did Ev marry after she divorced Bob, if anyone? Did she ever have any children (she had none by Bob) and, if so, who are they?

Finding her husband(s)

After her divorce, Evelyn married Kenneth Andrew Bachofer,¹⁰ who was born in Salina, Kansas, 25 May 1909.¹¹ Kenneth first married Ruth Clarke¹² 18 Aug 1934 and had two children by her.¹³ They were later divorced since she died as Ruth C Bachofer 4 Jan 1989, Friday Harbor, San Juan, Washington.¹⁴ Her son, Jon Michael Bachofer was born 14 Jun 1935 in Salina and died 24 May 1997, Seattle, King, Washington.¹⁵ Kenneth and Ruth had a second child, a daughter, Ruth Anne Bachofer, who was born 30 Nov 1938 in Salina. She, according to the obituary published at Kenneth's death, married a man named Patterson.¹⁶

There are two other mentions of Kenneth Bachofer in *The Salina Journal* over the years after 1951 (when the index begins). The first involved a donation of books to the Salina Public Library¹⁷ and the second listed his name amongst other delinquent property taxpayers.¹⁸

Kenneth A Bachofer died in San Francisco 15 May 1961, at his residence at 1051 Post St, apt 5, and, after cremation, was inurned at Woodlawn Cemetery [1000 El Camino Real, Colma, San Mateo, CA 94014, phone: 650-755-1727] on 18 May 1961.¹⁹ It seems quite certain that Ev married Kenneth Andrew Bachofer but it is not known exactly when or where yet.

My sister, Martha Linda, mentioned to me that Ev spoke to Ellen, our deceased sister, in Salina, as a child.²⁰ We moved there from Chanute in 1948 (when Ellen was 11) and Ellen lived there until she left for college in 1955.

Did Ev marry anyone else [besides Robert William Morris and Kenneth Andrew Bachofer]?

According to an online, undocumented source, Kenneth Andrew Bachofer married twice.²¹ The first time to Evelyn Hollister and the second time to Ruth Clarke. This is, of course, quite untrue. His first wife was Ruth Clarke. It is a bit much to expect him to have married two persons named Evelyn though it is certainly possible. It is far more likely that Ev Thom(p)son Morris married a man named Hollister after her divorce from Bob and then married Kenneth as her third husband. Mr Hollister has not yet been found. Whether she married others is not now known.

Did she have any children?

Having been born in 1899, she was 42 years old when she divorced Bob and it is unlikely, after 15 years of childless marriage to him that she would have had children by any other man though it is still possible. No other children are mentioned in the obituary for Kenneth other than the two who were born before 1941. According to *The Salina Journal*, Kenneth and Ruth (and children) traveled from Kansas City to visit his parents who were living in Salina in 1941.²²

What sort of work was Ev doing?

Evelyn Lamont Thom(p)son attended college at the University of Colorado (Boulder), Colorado State University (Fort Collins), and the University of Kansas (Lawrence). She was a freshman at Boulder in 1921-2. If that is the case, she probably graduated in 1926 and found her first job teaching in Denver in 1926-7. She was a teacher when she married Bob Morris. After her divorce, she remained in Denver to work. It is not known how long she remained there or specifically what she did.²³ At the time of Kenneth's death in San Francisco, Ev applied for credit with the funeral home handling the arrangements. Her application card states that she was working as a maid at the Mark Hopkins Hotel in San Francisco at that time.²⁴ It is not justified to assume that Ev had been working as a maid for all of the 19 years between her divorce from Bob in Denver and the death of Kenneth in 1961. But it seems clear that she probably did not return to teaching after taking a 15-year break from that profession during her marriage to Bob. So, she very likely worked catch-as-catch-can during the final 39 years of her life.

Evelyn has a brother named Holland, Mabel Francis diary, 11 Jul 1926; has a sister: Virginia Bode, living in Webster Grove (MO) (husband is Walter, Mabel Francis' diary 28 Aug 1928). Also Maggie (Margaret?) Brodie, supposedly living in St. Louis (Mabel Francis' diary 12 Jun 1928). Maggie Brodie is never seen in the census with Evelyn's parents though the other siblings are present as normal. There is a Matilda Thompson found in the California voter registrations. No census records bear out that Margaret is a child of Marie Kemper Thomson. She claims 3 children in 1910 (3 living) and all are listed in the family at that time. So, if Margaret is of this family, she must have been born after 1910. Then, to be married before 1928 makes her at most age 18 at marriage. [Margaret is almost certainly an artifact - the name Maggie is very poorly written in the diary and is probably Virginia and Brodie is Bode.] So Evelyn has only a brother, Arthur Holland (later changed to Holland K) and Virginia.
