Early in the Fall of 2004 the Board of the Albuquerque Archaeological Society was made aware of the lapse in publication of *Pottery Southwest*. We owe a debt of gratitude to Lori Reed for bringing this to our attention. After a series of discussions the Board agreed to undertake the creation of an electronic archive of all of the back issues from 1974-1996. Dolores Sundt kindly provided all the old master copies that she and her late husband Bill had maintained. For the next several months the recreation of *Pottery Southwest* became a labor of love culminating in the production of a searchable CD.

For over 20 years *Pottery Southwest* provided a venue for professional and avocational archaeologists to share questions and answers as well as research results. Reading through the back issues is akin to being privy to correspondence among many of the greats of Southwestern archaeology. It is a privilege to be able to offer this irreplaceable resource in a format that can aid in future research. Going forward, *Pottery Southwest* will be available on the world wide web. The Maxwell Museum of the University of New Mexico has graciously agreed to host *PSW's* website at *http://www.unm.edu/~psw*. Future issues will also be available on CDs annually.
