Two example sentences from Edo in the paper were garbled. The correct examples are given below.

(17) *ò yá ẹ́gógó wòrò
it made bell long
'It made the bell long.' (Baker 2003:41, ex. 46b)

(18) ozó (tòbòrè) yé (*tòbòrè) m̀s̀m̀s̀
Ozo (by.self) PRED (by.self) beautiful
'Ozo alone is beautiful.' (Baker 2003:43, ex. 51)
