The author and director each declare that the following conditions have been met:

2. The manuscript is essentially perfect with regard to its physical condition and form (margins, paper size and quality, spacing, type fonts);
3. The manuscript is complete and properly arranged (all appropriate sections are included, and all pages are numbered and in proper order);
4. The manuscript is without errors in the use of language (grammar, spelling, punctuation);
5. The reproduction quality of the manuscript is high (pages are clean and without streaks or smudges);
6. The manuscript is completely ready for binding and microfilming.

The Dean of Graduate Studies will have final authority with regard to the standards of quality listed above. Failure to meet these standards will result in the return of the manuscript to the student, and could cause the student's graduation to be delayed.
