The Master of Construction Management degree requires a core of 4 courses for a total of 11 credit hours (approximately one-third of the course requirements) together with elective courses to be selected from an approved list that includes management courses from Anderson Schools of Management, architecture and planning courses from the School of Architecture and Planning, and construction management courses from the School of Engineering. Both a 32 credit Plan I (thesis) and a 35 credit Plan II (non-thesis) options are offered.	Approve
