Biomedical Sciences	B	Biomd 672 - Structure and Function of Cell Nucleus (3 cr.). A survey of experimental approaches to study the relationship between nuclear structure and eukaryotic expression. No duplication; not repeatable.	Approve
Biomedical Sciences	B	Biomed 677 - Muscle Cell Biology Δ (1 cr.). An in-depth overview of muscle structure and function, muscle cell gene expression, and neuromuscular diseases. Can repeated for credit up to 6 credits; no duplication.	Approve
Planning	C	Add graduate minor in Community and Regional Planning. Requires 12 hours; 2 foundation courses (6 hours), a methods course (3 hours) and an elective (3 hours). The proposed minor coursework will provide students with a substantive background that while it won't give them a full professional training in CRP, will give them sufficient background to integrate the principles and practices of community and regional planning into their chosen profession (academic or applied).	Approve
Music	C	Change title of concentration from "Piano Accompanying" to "Collaborative Piano" to more accurately describe the role of pianist as an equal partner in music-making; addition of Music 595 (Accompanying) as required course; deletion of Music 549 (Accompanying Repertory) as required course; elimination of restriction on allowable hours of Music 560 (Ensemble Performance).	Approve
