The Barbara MacCaulley Scholarship is a cash award of approximately \$500 given each year to two outstanding UNM Undergraduate in Archaeology with preference given to female students.

Applicant must be 1) a full-time student entering their **senior** year with an anticipated graduation of December 2010 or May 2011; 2) a declared major in Anthropology with a concentration in Archaeology; 3) have a GPA of 3.0 or higher; 4) have a high motivation to pursue Archaeology as a career.

Interested students should write a letter of application to Dr. Ann F. Ramenofsky, Undergraduate Archaeology Advisor. This letter should explain interests, previous studies, goals in archaeology, and financial need. Included with the letter of application should be:

- 1) A transcript showing all anthropology courses and grades (an informal photocopy will do).
- 2) Two letters of recommendation from professors familiar with the students work, at least one of which must be on the Anthropology faculty.

The application should be sent to: Ann F. Ramenofsky, Undergraduate Archaeology Advisor, Anthropology Department, UNM. All application materials must be submitted by March 21, 2010.

The award will be announced by May 3, 2010, and will be presented at the May Commencement Ceremony of the Department of Anthropology.
