- (1) Non-residents are charged Resident rates for Summer only, except for students in the Nursing program (see Fall Tuition & Fee rates).
- (2) NU/Non-degree undergrad rates for students with no baccalaureate degree, except students in the Nursing program (see Fall Tuition & Fee rates).
- (3) NG/Non-degree grad rates for students with baccalaureate degree or higher, except students in the Nursing program (see Fall Tuition & Fee rates).
- (4) Add \$30 per credit hour for graduate level School of Architecture and Planning courses.
- (5) Add \$50 per credit hour for graduate level Anderson School of Management (ASM) courses.
