Name of Organization:

The University of New Mexico Chinese Christian Campus Fellowship

Purpose of Organization:

The University of New Mexico Chinese Christian Campus Fellowship (CCCF) exists to serve Chinese speaking students in an attitude of Christian love, to provide spiritual development for young believers, to build fellowship between members and to spread gospel on campus.

The core of CCCF is the fellowship meeting conducted once a week during which there is worship in song, Bible study, prayer and informal fellowship time.

Requirement of Membership:

Anyone interested in the purpose of the organization (as stated above) is welcome.

Officer:

1. New Officer are appointed yearly by the current officers with approval from the organization advisor. ½ of the officers need to be replaced every two years.

2. The president is responsible for organizing officer's meeting and, with other officers, overseeing the organization in accordance with the purpose of the organization.

Meeting:

CCCF will hold a fellowship meeting once a week unless a special event prevents the meeting.

Voting/Quorum:

Procedural matters will be voted on by headcount or general agreement at fellowship meetings. A majority of those present will be sufficient for passing a procedural decision.

Amending:

Decisions to amend the constitution and by-law must be approved by the organization advisors, the president and $\frac{2}{3}$ of the members presented for a vote and over $\frac{1}{2}$ of the total members.
