**Program:**

Participants of the HACU-UNM English Immersion Program will attend classes at CELAC ([www.unm.edu/celac](http://www.unm.edu/celac)). Areas of study include English reading, writing, speaking, listening and grammar. In general, classes meet for 4 hours a day, five days a week. The estimated weekly cost for 20 hours of instruction, books and materials is \$375.
