Final TOEFL Paper based Exam passing scores are submitted to UNM for admission purpose.

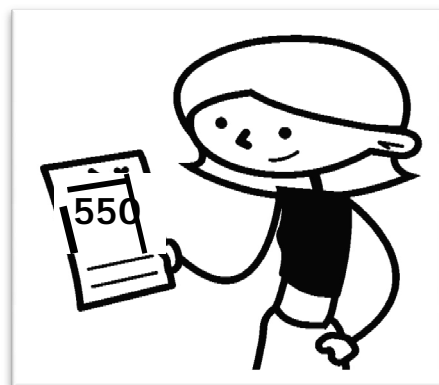
This course will be taught by Ben Sienicki, a CELAC instructor with experience preparing college students for standardized English exams.
