

# **SCHOLARSHIPS**

## **Department of Civil Engineering**

The Department of Civil Engineering is now accepting applications for twelve different SCHOLARSHIPS which will be awarded over the summer of 2010.

To be eligible for these scholarships, you must 1) be a current student in the department and meet the scholarship criteria, or 2) be admitted to UNM, meet the qualifications for admission to the department, be admitted into the department by June 5, 2010, and meet the scholarship criteria.

A SEPARATE APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR EACH SCHOLARSHIP FOR WHICH YOU ARE APPLYING. You can complete one application with all the information except the name of the scholarship, then copy your application and just write in the name of the specific scholarship.

**Each scholarship application form** for each individual scholarship **must include:**

- 1) Your most recent UNM unofficial academic transcript (you can print this in LoboWeb).
- 2) Transfer Course Evaluation (this applies to undergraduate students only - you can print this separately or as part of the LoboTrax Degree Audit in LoboWeb. Please click on, “Open All Sections,” before printing).
- 3) Other materials may be required for certain scholarships; read the scholarship announcement carefully.

To ensure that your application is complete, we strongly suggest that you submit all documents in one envelope. ONLY COMPLETE PACKETS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

READ THE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND ONLY APPLY FOR THE ONES FOR WHICH YOU CAN QUALIFY. You can find the criteria here on our web site, under “department list”:

**Some scholarships stipulate that you have financial need. If so, you must file the FAFSA for the 2010-2011 academic year.** Your FAFSA must be completely processed through the UNM Office of Financial Aid at the time that the decisions are made on the scholarships, or you will not be qualified for consideration.
