Regulations on Implementation of the Intellectual Property Policy


Open Source Software

This regulation implements section 2.7.2 of the Intellectual Property Policy, as it relates to Open Source Software.


Creators of computer software disseminate research results for scholarly purposes by making their software available in an open source format. The decision as to whether to release software created by a UNM creator through open source shall be the decision of the creator, subject to any contractual obligations to UNM or to third parties.

For purposes of this regulation, to "open source" software means to distribute it under a General Public License or other nonexclusive no-fee license providing the user rights to use, copy, distribute, and/or modify the software, and similar rights, with the requirement that if the user distributes copies or modifications, those copies or modifications must be distributed under the same nonexclusive no-fee license terms.


