

# Laguna Pueblo Community Report, 2006

## Demographics

In 2006, there were 2,126 licensed drivers in the Laguna Pueblo. Of these, there were 1,134 females and 992 males. The total number of crashes in 2006 was 66, yielding a crash rate of 31 per thousand licensed drivers (total number of crashes 66 divided by total number of licensed drivers 2,126 times 1,000). The corresponding rate for the state was 36 per thousand licensed drivers.

## General Crash Information

Since 1997 the number of crashes has shown no consistent pattern. Fatal and injury crashes have also shown no consistent pattern since 1997. Belt usage (as a percentage) has remained virtually unchanged from last year, while belt usage in crashes involving visible and incapacitating injuries has increased.

## Alcohol-related Crash Information

Information about alcohol-involved crashes is included in all sections of this report. In the last two years, there have been no people reported arrested for DWI in Laguna Pueblo.

## Crash Specifics

Crashes involving other vehicles were the most common class, accounting for 42 percent of all crashes. Crashes involving other vehicles were the most common crash class which resulted in fatalities. Semis were the vehicle type most often involved in crashes, accounting for 34 percent of all vehicles in crashes. Passenger cars accounted for 26 percent of vehicles involved in crashes. Together these two vehicle types comprised 48 percent of the vehicles involved in injury crashes. The two most common top contributing factors were driver inattention and excessive speed. There were five fatal crashes in 2006. The most common top contributing factors for the fatal crashes were alcohol involvement and driver inattention.

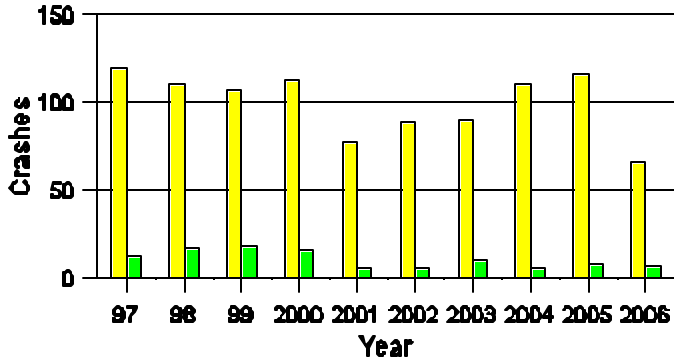
## People in Crashes

Overall, males were 80 percent of drivers in crashes, although they account for only 47 percent of licensed drivers in Laguna Pueblo. There have been no pedestrians involved in crashes in the last two years. In 2006, two 'teenagers' and no young adults were killed in crashes in Laguna Pueblo. Statewide 16 percent of alcohol-involved drivers were under 21; in Laguna Pueblo 33% (2 in 6) were under 21.

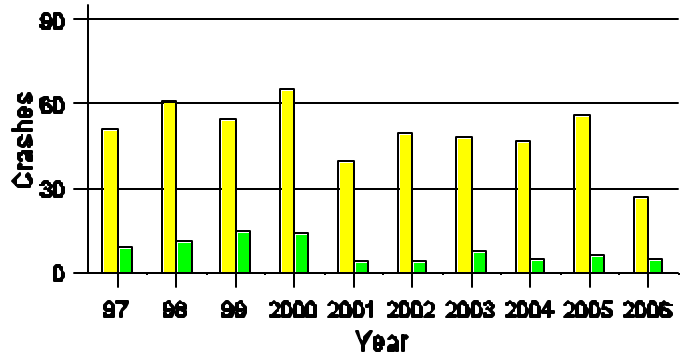

### Crashes in Laguna Pueblo by Alcohol Involvement



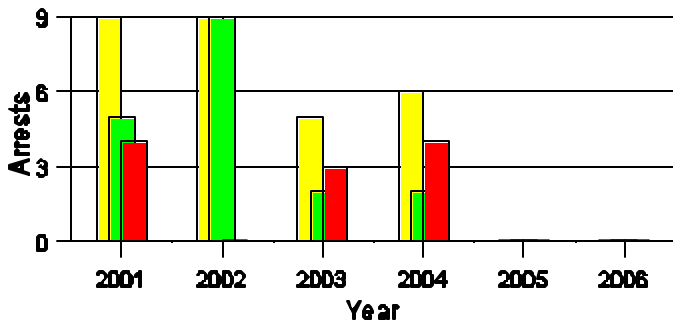
### Fatal and Injury Crashes in Laguna Pueblo by Alcohol Involvement



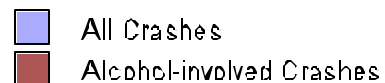
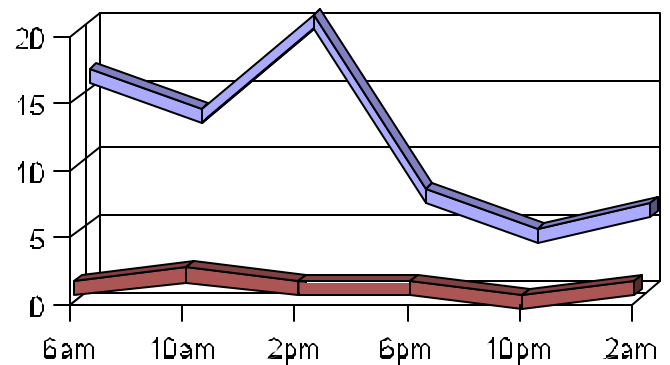

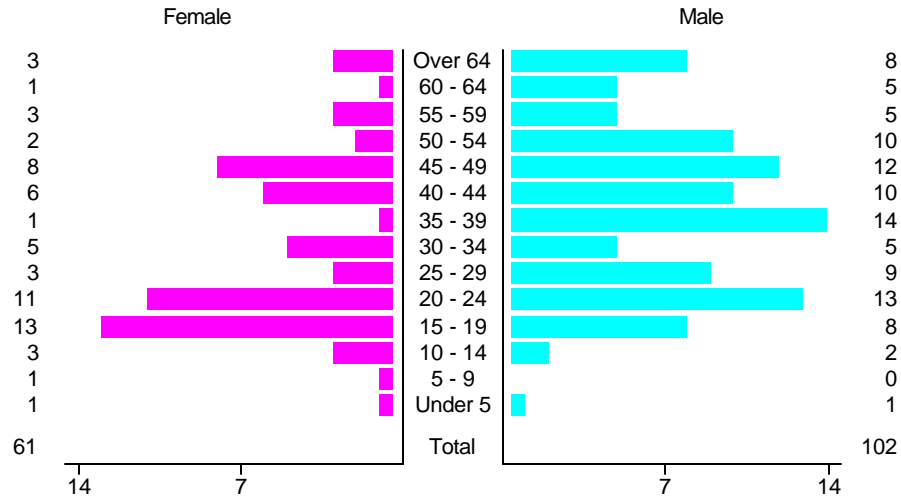

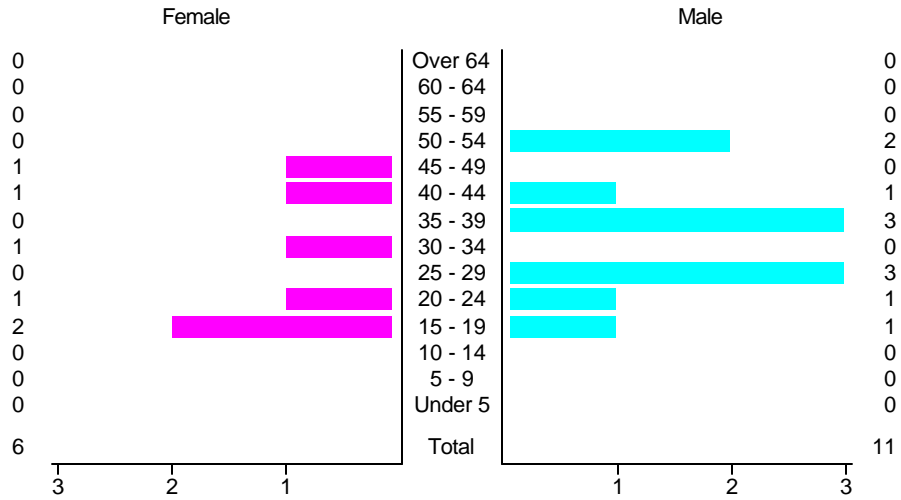

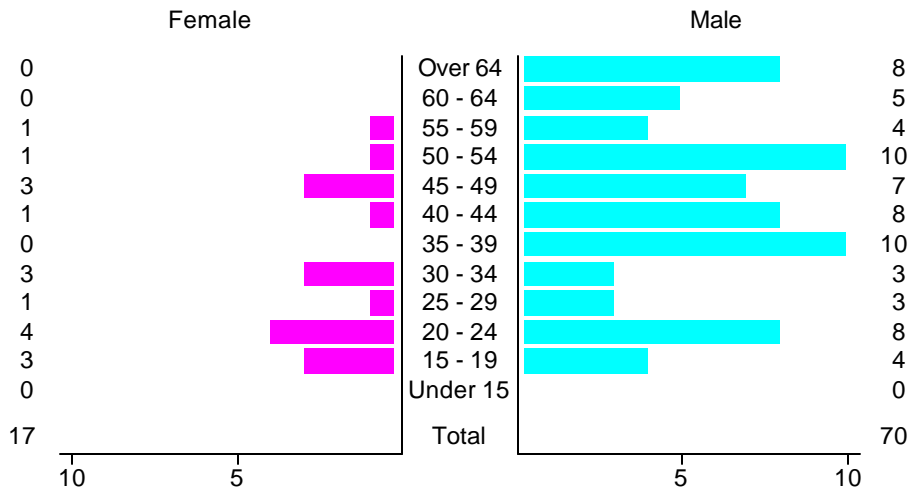
**People in Crashes in Laguna Pueblo, 2006  
by Age and Sex**



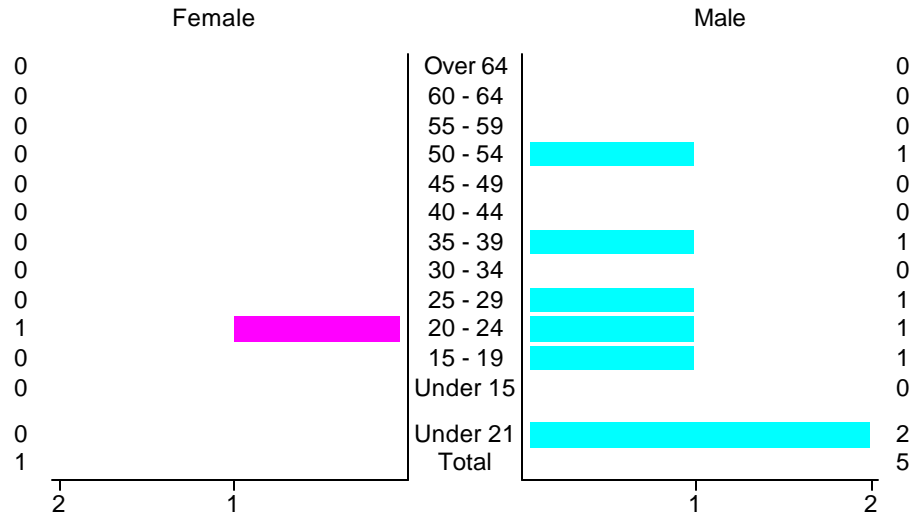
**People in Alcohol-Involved Crashes in Laguna Pueblo, 2006  
by Age and Sex**



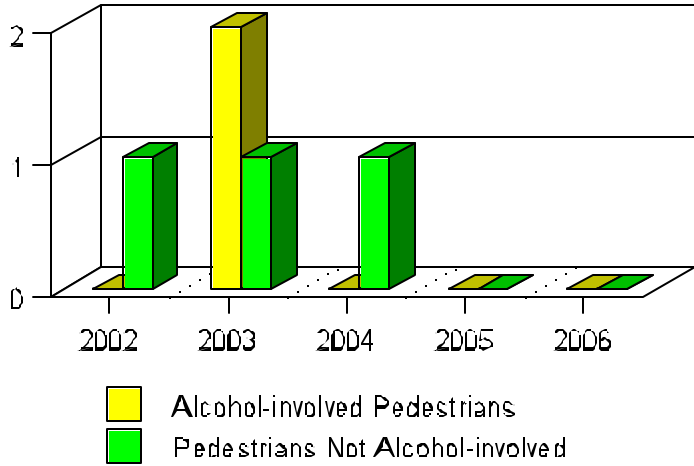
**Drivers in Crashes by Age and Sex in Laguna Pueblo, 2006**



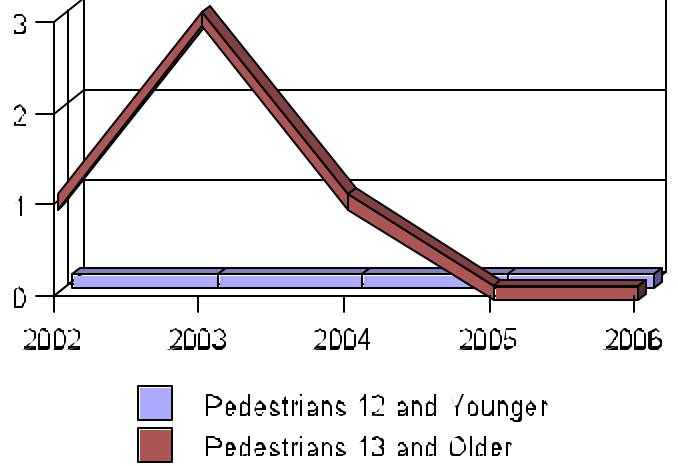
**Alcohol-Involved Drivers in Crashes in Laguna Pueblo, 2006
