Regarding Summer and Academic Year Study
in the

Because the Educational Leadership doctorate is designed for working professionals, the program works hard to schedule coursework in ways that respect students' working lives. At the same time, it's important for students to be able to fully participate in all coursework. Although the program doesn't require supervisory "approval" to enroll in the program, it is important to have conversations with those who might be affected by your decision to pursue doctoral study.
