STRUCKMAN-JOHNSON, 1988

Methods:

- Survey of 623 University of South Dakota students in 1985. Women and sophomores overrepresented.
- Followup survey of 301 students asking more questions about nature of forced sex incidents.
- Interviews with 52.

Findings:

	Women	Men
Ever forced to have sex	22%	16%
On campus	13%	9%
Have forced someone to have sex	2%	10%
On campus	1%	3%

MYTHS ABOUT MALE SEXUALITY (FROM BERNIE ZILBERGELD: <u>Male Sexuality</u> (1978)

1. MEN SHOULD NOT HAVE CERTAIN FEELINGS

2. IN SEX, AS ELSEWHERE, IT IS PERFORMANCE THAT COUNTS.

3. THE MAN MUST TAKE CHARGE OF AND ORCHESTRATE SEX.

4. THE MAN IS ALWAYS READY AND ALWAYS WANTS TO HAVE SEX.

5. ALL PHYSICAL CONTACT MUST LEAD TO SEX.

6. SEX EQUALS INTERCOURSE.

7. SEX REQUIRES AN ERECTION.

EROSION OF THE DOUBLE STANDARD?

From R&C: 170-172

1. By 1998, sexual experience gap had closed: Age at first sexual intercourse now 15 for both boys and girls.

2. % of Americans who think that premarital sex is always wrong decreased from 37% in 1972 to 19.7% in the 1990s.

More oral and less vaginal sex among teens.
"I did not have sexual relations with that woman!"

BUT

4. Girls have more guilt and less pleasure.

5.Boys and girls give different reasons for starting sexual activity:

Boys: Status, curiosity, was ready (51% vs. 24% girls)
```

Girls: Affection for partner and approval (48% vs. 25% boys)
