In accordance with Federal regulations, to be eligible to receive a National SMART Grant for a semester, students must be enrolled in at least one course that meets the specific requirements of their National SMART Grant-eligible major.

It is not necessary that the course be offered by the academic department that confers the degree in the eligible major. For example, a student majoring in biology is eligible to receive a National SMART Grant during a semester in which he or she is enrolled in a physics course if the physics course is required for the major, even if the student is not enrolled in any biology courses.

A student who is taking general education courses or electives that satisfy general degree requirements for the student's National SMART Grant-eligible program, but who is not taking at least one course specific to and required for the National SMART Grant-eligible major, is not eligible for a National SMART Grant payment for Spring semester, 2008.
