Do not include partial days when calculating $20 \%$ of completion. For example, $20 \%$ of an eight day course equals 1.6 days. Refund is calculated only if dropped on or before the first day.

Courses five days or less in duration must be dropped on or before the first day of the course to receive a full refund.

Correspondence Courses are fully refundable if dropped before 9\% of the course has been completed. Do not include partial days when calculating $9 \%$ of completion.
