The Department of Media Arts at the University of New Mexico, College of Fine Arts, invites applications for a **lecturer in video/digital production**.

**Rank and Salary/ Start date:** Lecturer III at .75 FTE; salary \$24,000. Position begins August 14, 2006.

**Responsibilities:** Our successful candidate will teach introductory and advanced production courses in digital moving image arts at the undergraduate and graduate levels.

**Minimum qualifications:** MFA in Cinema/Media Studies or in a related interdisciplinary field.

**Preferred Qualifications:** We prefer to hire an artist/scholar who has 1) a comprehensive record of work screened in prominent places in the United States or abroad; 2) experience teaching production courses, at the college or university level, *vis-à-vis* contemporary criticism, theory, and cultural studies; 3) a national reputation as an artist; 4) a record as an excellent and experienced instructor; 5) experience as a festival curator or commentator; 6) demonstrated engagement with interlocking diversities represented in media arts.

**Application Process:** Please send hard copies of your current cv and a signed letter of application; a short portfolio of moving image work (not to exceed thirty minutes); up to ten pages of photocopied material regarding curatorial work, conference presentations, or other material you might wish to include in dossier; sample course syllabi (no more than two); student evaluations of teaching (concise format); plus the names, e-mail addresses, and phone numbers of at least three persons who would be available this summer to write letters of recommendation on your behalf. For best consideration, completed applications must be received by June 16, 2006. Position will remain open until filled.
