# ARRA Awards

---

- As of September 30, 2009:
- 40 Awards received to date
  - 38 prime awards and 2 sub-awards
    - 3 HRSA, 1 NSF, 34 NIH
    - MIND and State of NM (CYFD)
- Total dollars awarded \$18,875,786
- First year dollars \$12,516,845

# Reporting

---

- 1<sup>st</sup> reports due Oct 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Submitted all on or before Oct 8<sup>th</sup>
- Comments / feedback
  - Can't have jobs with no expenditures
  - No reports due on awards < \$25,000
  - Issue date vs Award date
- No other comments – yet!
- Reports published on Oct 31

# Reporting, cont'd

---

- Federal reporting system:
- Update access only
  - No “view only” access available
- No report / extract / export capability
- Data entry website
- Print-out's available for review
  - Contact us for appointment

# Reporting, cont'd

---

- Things to keep in mind:
- No names, please
  - Replace with titles as appropriate
- Limit details in progress report
  - Confidential / proprietary information
- No reports due on “shell” accounts
  - Not awarded by funding agency

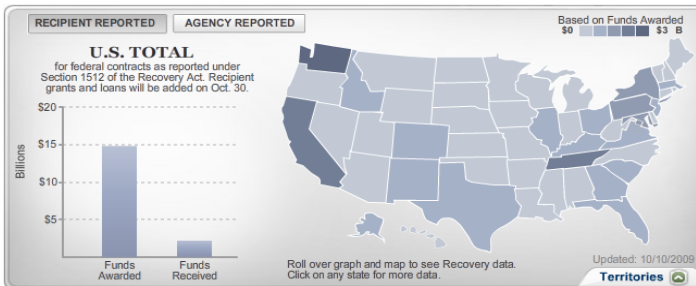

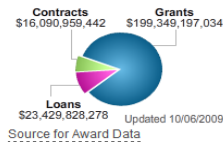
