

A way to create a slide show on your Web page

Modify photos by cropping and using color balance, save to 4 inches wide and 72 dpi, and upload with FTP software to Mojo Web site. **Make sure all photos are the same width or you will end up with the column shifting side to side between pictures. Also, make sure photos are the same depth if you're putting any text underneath, or the story below will be moving up and down as each photo is displayed.**

IMPORTANT: Place photo files inside your story_pages "images" folder.

Change permissions on photos to 755 or 0755 (depending on Mac system) or do your webupdate on Windows so photos are published to the Web.

Use browser to call up <http://www.barelyfitz.com/projects/slideshow/wizard/> and follow directions. I recommend you click on the "Play the Video Demo" in the upper right-hand corner of the site for a video of instructions.

Although Step 1 says "optional," type in the base URL of http://www.unm.edu/~themojo/story_pages/images/ (make sure you include final slash).

Set slide duration to 3,000 to 6000 (three to six seconds), and check-mark the controls panels for previous, next, play and stop.

In the "Edit your slides section," type in the photo file name EXACTLY as you named the file, type in the Web site link to http://www.unm.edu/~themojo/story_pages/images/ (make sure you include final slash), and in the "description" box write your outline. To avoid a jerking motion of your photos, make sure all outlines end up with the same number of lines when they're displayed in Dreamweaver. You can ignore the "link target" and "window images" boxes.

Click the "Add Slide" button for your first slide. For each new slide, change the name of the photo file and the cutline and click the "Add Slide" button.

Make sure the image of your picture shows beneath the "slides" window. If it doesn't show, you've done something wrong. You might need to reload the barelyfitz page and start all over to make it work if you have a mistake.

Generate the HTML coding; select and copy that HTML coding. Minimize the barelyfitz window in case you need to come back and update any slides.

Call up your Dreamweaver story page, and in the right hand column type "SLIDE SHOW" and hit return. Type an "X." Go to "split" window in upper left corner and find where "X" is located. Make sure you click where the cursor is inside that coding window. Then select the "X" and paste HTML coding from barelyfitz. Return to "design" window. Save and preview on browser.

Update slides on barelyfitz if necessary.
