

**Department of History
Dissertation Fellowships**

Applications for the following fellowships are evaluated by History faculty each spring. To apply, please submit all materials as indicated below by April 15.

Dudley Phillips Dissertation Fellowship

This year the Department will award one Fellowship of approximately \$10,000. The Phillips Fellowship is awarded annually to a qualified advanced graduate student in History to support completion of the dissertation. Recipients must have completed all parts of the Ph.D comprehensive examination. Candidates should submit a letter of application, a description of the dissertation or copy of the approved prospectus, and a letter of support from the dissertation director.

John F. Kennedy Memorial Award

The Kennedy award of approximately \$1,000 will be given to a student for support of dissertation research in Southwest History. Candidates should submit a short (1-2 page) research proposal, a statement of projected expenses, and a letter of support from the dissertation director.

Dorothy Woodward Memorial Fellowship

This fellowship of approximately \$8,000 is available for History Department Ph.D students writing dissertations in the history of the Southwest and/or Mexican-American Borderlands. Recipients must have served as a Graduate Assistant for at least one year. Candidates should submit a short (1-2 page) research proposal, projected budget, and two letters of support.
