

International Studies Institute Summer Scholarships 2009 for Language Training, Research Projects, and/or Study Abroad

The International Studies Institute announces its annual scholarship competition for summer research projects, language training, and/or study abroad programs related to International Studies. The Committee will award up to \$1000 per scholarship winner. To apply, a person must be enrolled as a continuing undergraduate student at UNM, but need not be in one of the International Studies Institute programs (European Studies, Russian Studies, Asian Studies), although preference is given to such students.

Application Checklist:

- A cover sheet that includes your name, address, phone number, email address, and intended semester and year of graduation;
- A 250-word narrative describing your project, along with supporting documentation;
- A one-page itemized budget indicating expected expenses, specifying how much money you are requesting from the ISI, and explaining how you plan to meet expenses with or without ISI funding;
- Your most recent unofficial UNM transcript;
- Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a faculty member at UNM — sealed in an envelope, signed, and included with your application.

Application must be typed on plain white paper, held together with a paper clip.

Preference will be given to applicants who wish to study a language intensively at a summer institute or another university, who design international research or study projects, or who plan to enroll in a study abroad program, and who are pursuing a European Studies, Russian Studies, or Asian Studies major or minor.
