***2011-1012 MUN Scholarships***

The International Studies Institute announces its scholarship competition for UNM students participating and competing in National or World Model United Nations (MUN) conferences during the 2011-2012 academic year.

During Fall 2011, the scholarship committee will award a total of \$800 to support up to 2 UNM students who are confirmed participants of a National and/or World MUN conference. Eligible applicants must be undergraduate students at UNM with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. **Preference will be given to students enrolled in one of the ISI programs (Asian, European, or International Studies).**

***Application Materials:***

- A cover sheet with your name, address, phone number, and email address;
- A 300-450 word narrative describing your program of study and how you expect to benefit from participating in one of the MUN conferences in terms of your education and future career plans;
- A one-page itemized budget for your trip (with supporting documentation), specifying how much you are requesting from the ISI and explaining how you plan to meet expenses with and without ISI funding;
- Your current unofficial UNM transcript;
- One letter of recommendation from a full-time faculty member at UNM — sealed in an envelope, signed, and included with your application.

Applications must be typed on plain white paper, held together with a paper clip.
