PURPOSE: The Water Forum is convened to bring together invited guests and members of the UNM community engaged in water research and creative activities so we may learn from one another and share our work; and to continue a dialogue that will lead to collaborations, partnerships, and syntheses of ideas for expansion of interdisciplinary research and creative activity on water topics.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: University faculty, staff and students, and members of the larger New Mexico water community interested in water issues and solutions to practical problems.

ABOUT THE FORUM: Presentation topics include the 2006 monsoon; the Middle Rio Grande urban flood demonstration program; community acequias; water leasing markets; and potable reuse of municipal wastewater. Bill Hume (invited), Director of Policy and Issues, Office of the Governor Bill Richardson, will speak on the Year of Water. Erik Webb, Sandia National Laboratories and detailed to the staff of Senator Pete Domenici, will talk about the Water/Energy Nexus. A special feature of this year's Forum is The Rio Grande Seminar lecture by environmental historian Dan Scurlock. He will present on the *History of the Rio Grande*.
