

Qualifications:

Candidates interested in competing for the honor of Homecoming court must have the following qualifications:

- * A male (King) or female (Queen)
- * Undergraduate Main Campus Student carrying at least six (6) credit hours
- * Not on any type of University probation
- * At least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average. The only exception for not having a 2.5 cumulative GPA is if the student does not have a GPA due to newly entering the University.

Deadline:

Application/Grade Release form is due to ASUNM (Student Union Building Room 1016) by **5:00 pm on Wednesday, September 14th, 2011.** Campaign rules and regulations and royalty schedule will be discussed at the **Mandatory Meeting Thursday, September 15th, at 6:00 pm in Student Union Building 3rd Floor, Acoma Room A.** The Homecoming King and Queen will be elected by popular vote by the undergraduate student body at the main campus of the University of New Mexico on Wednesday, September 21st, 2011.

Requirements:

- * Submit the King & Queen Application/Grade Release Form by 5:00 pm to ASUNM (Student Union Bldg Rm 1016), on Weds, September 14th, 2011.
- * Must agree to follow all Rules & Regulations (See attached page)
- * Email a Digital Photo (At least 1MB - Head Shot Best - NO Facebook Photos<They're too small>) to lobosprt@unm.edu by 8:00 pm, Weds, Sept 14th **OR** you can take one with our camera at the mandatory meeting on Thursday.
- * Attend a Mandatory Meeting for all candidates on Thursday, September 15th at 6:00 pm in SUB Acoma A Room on the 3rd floor. **If you can not attend, you must send a representative to take your place. Failure to attend, or to send a representative, will result in disqualification.**
- * Must attend all events on the royalty schedule which will be distributed at the mandatory meeting.
- * Must attend, or make alternative arrangements for the following events:

- Fall Frenzy event on Friday, Sept 16th on campus.
- Homecoming Court announcement at the pep rally on Friday, September 23rd, Noon, SUB Atrium.
- Homecoming Dance Friday night, September 23rd.

Coronation:

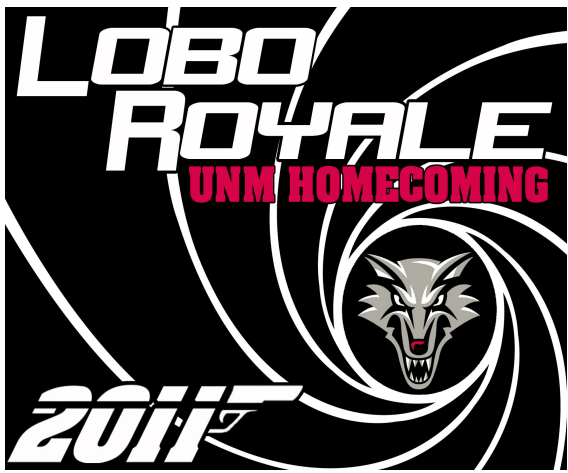
Attendance of the Coronation of the King and Queen and the court is mandatory and will take place on Saturday, September 24th, 2011 during the halftime celebration of the football game against SHSU. If a court member shows any signs of the use of alcohol or drugs, inappropriate dress or behavior before the ceremony or anything deemed a detriment to the position, the candidate will be disqualified immediately by the Student Activities Center representative and not allowed to participate in the halftime ceremony.
