

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

New Mexico August Folk Dance Camp 2008 is seeking campers willing to work a bit for a big reduction in camp fees.

SWIFDI August Camp 2008 (7-10 August) in Socorro, New Mexico on the campus of New Mexico Tech features renowned teachers **Tommy & Ewa Englund** teaching Swedish Couples dances and **Lee Otterholt** teaching Albanian, Balkan & Greek dances.

Scholarship folks are vital to the success of August Camp. In exchange for a limited amount of work, you can receive a scholarship for about half the cost of camp. Duties will include such non-strenuous activities as monitoring music during teaching and parties, sweeping floors, keeping snack tables full, and general go-fering. Scholarship recipients need to attend all of camp because on Thursday help is needed to set up tables, signs etc before camp and also clean up at the end of camp on Sunday afternoon. Reasonable scheduling allows scholarship campers to attend teaching sessions and parties while performing their duties. Scholarships of \$110.00 are applied to camper fee which makes coming about half of the normal cost.

Requirements for consideration of an AC 2008 scholarship are *dependability*, the *willingness* to participate in duties, and a *commitment* to attend all of camp Thursday – Sunday, 7-10 August 2008. The commitment to camp begins at 10:00 am on Thursday, August 7 through 1:00pm Sunday, August 10th.
