### **What is the OLIT Expo?**

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As a community of scholars, the Graduate Professional Student Association (GPSA) and faculty invite OLIT undergraduate and graduate students to gather and present their research and applied projects, including multimedia projects and highlights from their academic and professional development. The Expo provides an opportunity for students to support, share, and learn from one another.

In addition, the Expo is another way for individuals outside the program to learn about OLIT and to experience OLIT student work. You will be asked to help advertise and invite others who are interested in the program.

### **When/Where will the OLIT Expo be held?**

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The 2009 OLIT Expo will occur on Friday, April 24th from 5 to 7 p.m. in the College of Education's Technology Education Center. Refreshments will be served at 5 p.m.

### **What kind of presentations will there be at the OLIT Expo?**

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The OLIT Expo will cover a wide range of subjects and interests. Students in the OLIT undergraduate and graduate programs are invited to submit proposals for the Expo. Presentations are grouped into three categories, and may be presented by an individual or a group.

- ❖ **Multimedia:** Projects from courses, internships, or your portfolio project.
- ❖ **Portfolio:** Master students may want to display their portfolios. Other students may want to use posters to display their work from research, internships, directed readings, independent studies, etc.
- ❖ **Research:** An opportunity for MA and PhD students to practice and present their research, including thesis and dissertations. You may also present research that is in progress.

## How do I submit a proposal to present?

- A final format for the day will be decided upon by the Program Committee after all program proposals have been reviewed.
- Submission of a proposal signifies your commitment to attend the event and make your presentation.
- ***All presentations will be posters.***
