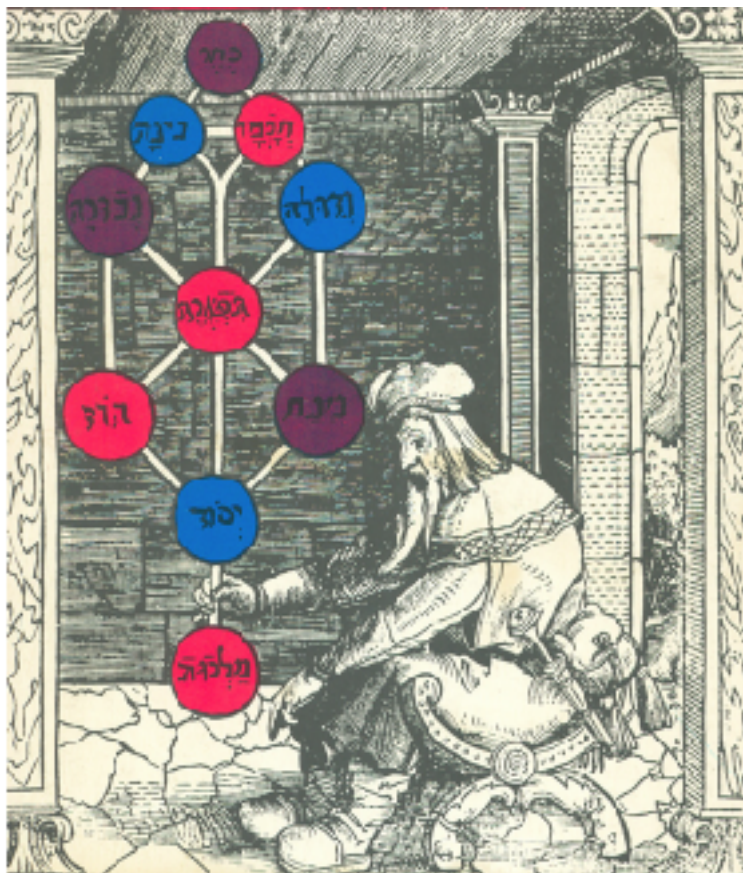


JEWISH MYSTICISM & KABBALAH

This course will explore the major forms of Jewish mysticism, from antiquity to the present. It will include the Zohar (*Book of Splendor*) and Hasidism, the popular 18th century movement that continues in the modern world. We will explore Kabbalistic texts in English translation and wrestle with their meaning for contemporary experience.

INSTRUCTOR: Michael Nutkiewicz, PhD, focuses on classical Jewish thought and texts, modern Jewish religious and social movements, and practical ethics and human rights.
