The University of New Mexico Amigo Scholarship Program and the Amigo Transfer Scholarship Program entitle outstanding OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS (Non-Residents) to a waiver of the out-of-state tuition portion granting a student in-state tuition and an award of \$250 per semester provided a student meets renewal requirements.

Amigo Scholarship for Freshmen Students

Students applying for this scholarship *must*:

1. Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) and an ACT composite score of 23 or the SAT equivalent of 1060 (combined mathematics and critical reading scores only);
-OR-
2. Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) and an ACT composite of 26 or the SAT equivalent of 1170 (combined mathematics and critical reading scores only).

The scholarship may be renewed annually for up to four years provided the student meets requirements of 15 credit hours and a 3.0 GPA *each* semester. A student who fails to meet the requirements necessary to renew the scholarship also forfeits the privilege of resident tuition and may not petition for residency status for a period of one year.

Amigo Transfer Scholarship for Undergraduate Students

Undergraduate transfer students *must*:

1. Have a combined transfer college grade point average of 3.50 or higher;
-OR-
1. Have a combined cumulative transfer college grade point average of 3.25 or higher (on a 4.0 scale); **and**
2. Have at least 30 hours of credited transfer hours; **and**
3. Also meet the High School criteria for the Amigo Scholarship listed above

The scholarship may be renewed annually for up to two years provided the student meets requirements of 12 credit hours and a 3.0 GPA *each* semester. A student who fails to meet the requirements necessary to renew the scholarship also forfeits the privilege of resident tuition and may not petition for residency status for a period of one year.

Cherry Silver Scholarship

Non-residents only
Approximately \$5,000 per year
Four-year, renewable award

1. Applicants who apply for and do not receive the Amigo Scholarship will be considered for this scholarship.

Due to the high number of applicants each year for this award, students are encouraged to apply early for admission and scholarships. The Amigo/Amigo Transfer Scholarship is awarded on a continuous first-come-first-served basis (beginning March 31) until funds are exhausted. Therefore, we strongly encourage you to submit your application prior to **May 1** for the Fall semester and **November 1** for the Spring semester.
