

# 2018-2019 School of Engineering Incoming Freshman Scholarship Application (For current H.S. Seniors)

PRIORITY DEADLINE: February 1, 2018 (Engineering Scholarships open to Incoming Freshmen only)

GENERAL DEADLINE: June 1, 2018 (Engineering Scholarships open to all students admitted in the School of Engineering at UNM). If you submit an application by February 1st, you do not need to re-apply by June 1st.

### **Scholarship Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Student must be a <u>current</u> H.S. Senior
- 2. Student must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- 3. For most awards, student must have a minimum 22 in ACT-Math or 510 in SAT-Math (Most recent ACT/SAT Math score will be considered). However, <u>THERE ARE ALTERNATIVES</u> to this requirement, contact us for details.
- 4. Student must be interested in majoring in Engineering or Computer Science at the University of New Mexico
- 5. Although not required at the time of application for this scholarship, in order to be considered eligible to compete for an UNM-Engineering scholarship, students *must* be admitted into UNM *and* the UNM- School of Engineering by the time of the scholarship selection. As part of the scholarship pre-screening process, the School of Engineering will review all scholarship applications received. Students already in the UNM system who meet minimum requirements for admission into the UNM School of Engineering will be automatically admitted as Incoming Freshmen in the Pre-major Program in each department and their scholarship applications will be forwarded to the Engineering Scholarship Selection Committee.
