FOR SPANISH SPEAKERS:

**PORT 277 - 001 INTENSIVE PORTUGUESE
FOR SPANISH SPEAKERS**

(CRN 35198) MWF 1-1:50 pm & TTh 12:30-1:45 pm

This intensive language class is designed for students with strong Spanish skills; native Spanish speakers or for students with three years of college level Spanish.

This class has an ***accelerated*** pace due to the similarities between the Spanish and Portuguese languages.

The students' knowledge of Spanish will be utilized for comparison purposes and as a base for building Portuguese language skills.

Successful completion of this course may fulfill the third language requirement for Spanish majors.

Meets 5 days a week (6 credit hours).

The next course to take is Portuguese 301 or 311.

**PORT 102 - 001 ELEMENTARY PORTUGUESE II
(CRN 30093) MWF 1 – 1:50 pm**

This course is for native Spanish speakers and/or students with three years of college level in Spanish. The materials covered in the course are the same as those of Portuguese 101 and more.

Portuguese language skills will be developed based on comparison and contrast with the Spanish language.

This course will progress at a slower pace covering half the material of Portuguese 277 – 001.

Fulfills Core Curriculum Language requirement.

Prepares students for advanced courses in Portuguese.

Meets 3 days a week (3 credit hours).

The next course to take is Portuguese 276.

FOR BEGINNING LANGUAGE LEARNERS:

**PORT 275 – 002 INTENSIVE BEGINNING PORTUGUESE
(CRN 13064) MWF 11-11:50 am & TTh 11-12:15 pm**

This course is for students with little knowledge of Spanish – or any other Romance language – who want to learn Portuguese quickly.

This course introduces Portuguese as a world language with in-class activities conducted in Portuguese, such as: small group activities; dialogues; answering and asking questions; watching videos; practicing grammar structures; listening to songs and doing activities based on them.

Meets 5 days a week (6 credit hours).

The next course to take is Portuguese 276.

**PORT 101 - 001 ELEMENTARY PORTUGUESE I
(CRN 27933) MWF 10 – 10:50 am**

This course is for students who have little or no previous experience with Portuguese, Spanish, or any other Romance language.

This course presents Portuguese as a world language and is designed to develop language skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Students will be expected to develop the ability to communicate in Portuguese in everyday situations. Grades are based on exams, homework, and regular classroom participation.

Fulfills Core Curriculum Language requirement.

Meets 3 days a week (3 credit hours).

The next course is Portuguese 102.
