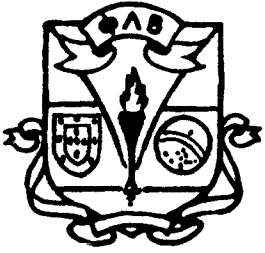


# PHI LAMBDA BETA

**Phi Lambda Beta** is a national honor society composed of undergraduate and graduate students who have shown outstanding achievement in the study of Portuguese language, culture, and literature. Students are selected each year from eligible candidates to be initiated. In order to be considered for this honor, a student must have completed three years of college Portuguese or the equivalent in language classes and at least one course at the 400 level in literature or culture. Graduate students must have been in residence for one year in order to be eligible for selection. All students must have maintained a grade point average of 3.25 in Portuguese courses and a 2.75 overall.
