Dear Prospective Student:

Many students who are interested in our master's program in speech-language pathology have bachelor's degrees in other fields. If that describes, you, welcome! The diversity of our students' backgrounds makes for an interesting mix of talents and viewpoints, and improves the educational experience for all of us.

We can consider your application for our graduate program only after you have completed at least 9 semester hours of undergraduate courses in the speech and hearing sciences curriculum, with a GPA of at least 3.3. This means that you will need to begin your professional education as a non-degree student. On our website (www.unm.edu/~sphrsci/), you will find a non-degree application form and advisement materials showing the general sequence of courses that you will need to complete. We have an advisor who specializes in helping non-degree students to select their pre-requisite course sequence and apply to our graduate program. Please note that you will be eligible for the various forms of graduate financial aid only after you are accepted as a graduate student.
