**TEAMWORK** works in tutoring and helped make our 2008 Awards and Recognition Banquet a success!



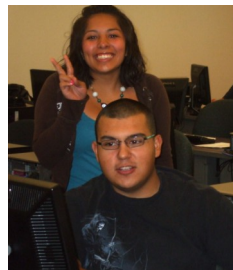
## *TRiO* / *onTRAC* offers students:

### Student Membership

*onTRAC* students are required to make a commitment to the program by:

- Successfully completing the *onTRAC* First Year Experience course in summer or fall semester - EDUC 293, 2cr.
- Attending the *onTRAC* orientation prior to the fall semester
- Meeting with an *onTRAC* advisor monthly during each semester
- Participating in *onTRAC* sponsored events



## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students who meet one or more of the following criteria set by the U.S. Department of Education may apply to the *onTRAC* program:

- First generation college student- neither parent graduated with a Bachelor degree
- Income eligible-Department of Education income guidelines
- Disabled – documented physical or learning disability

**We accept new students prior to the fall semester only.**
