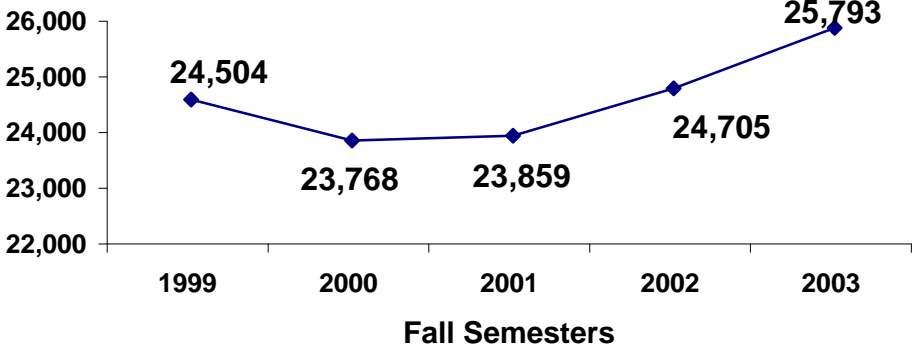

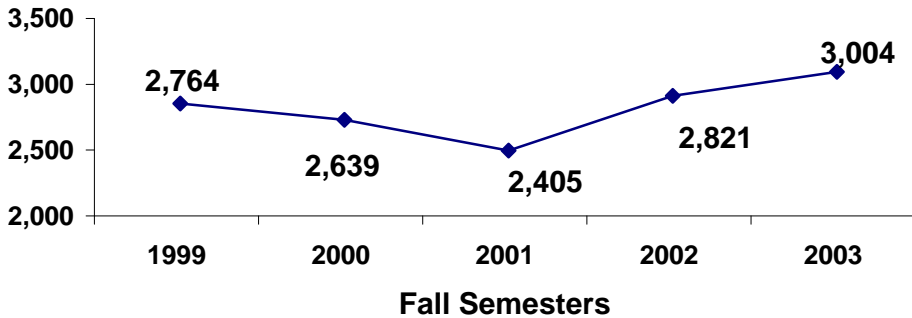

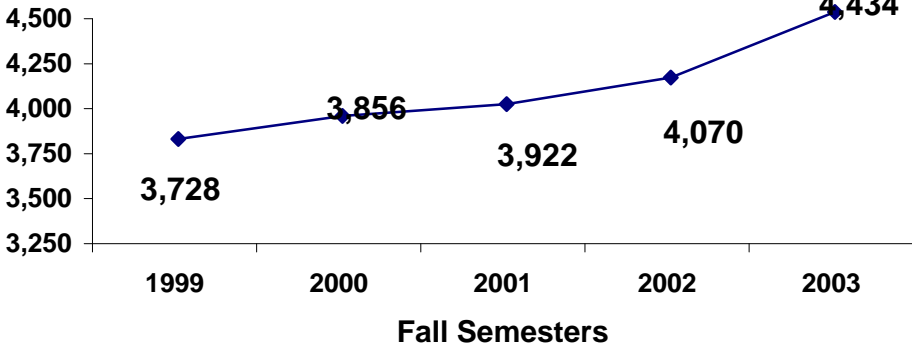
UNM Main Campus Headcount

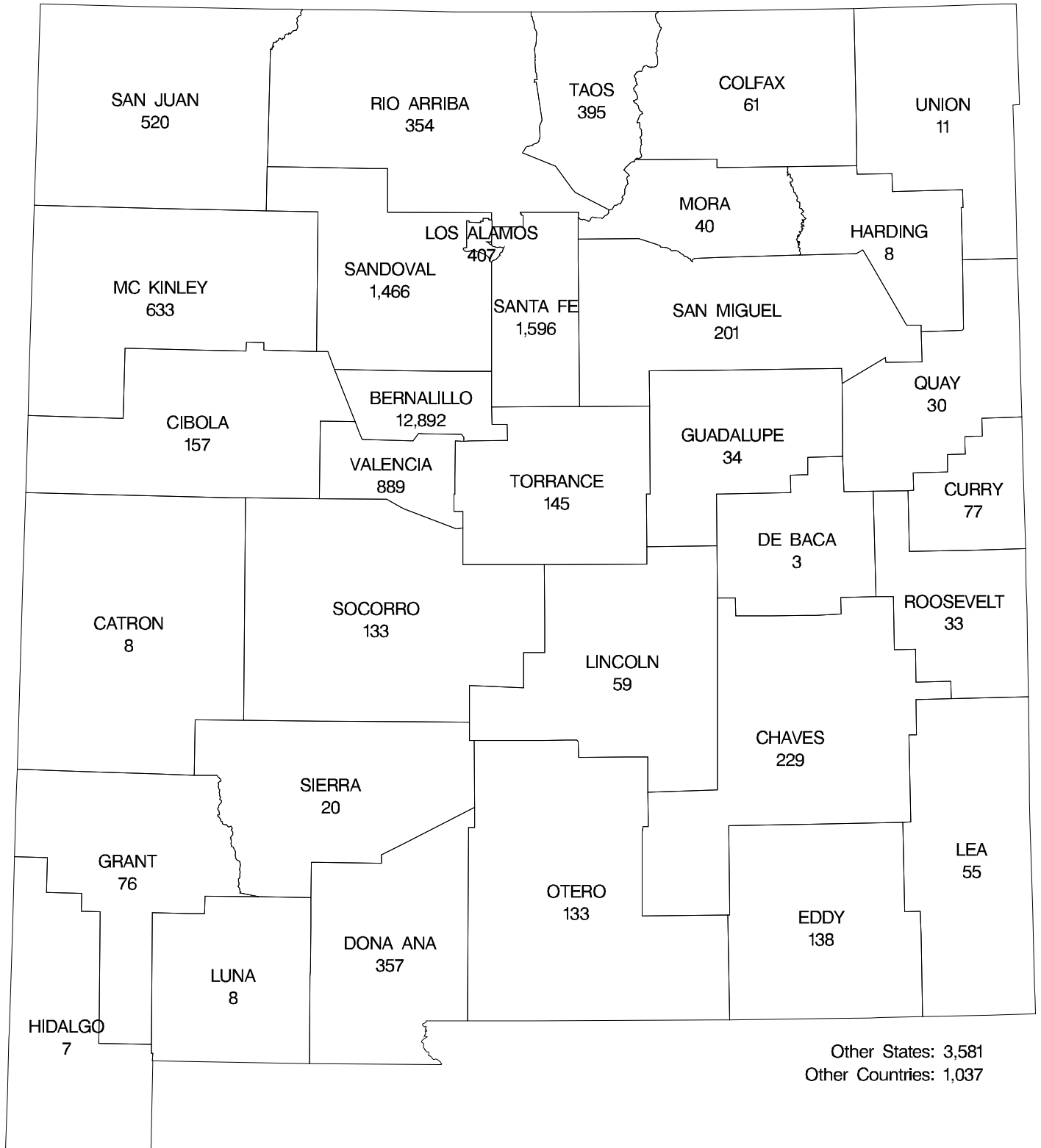

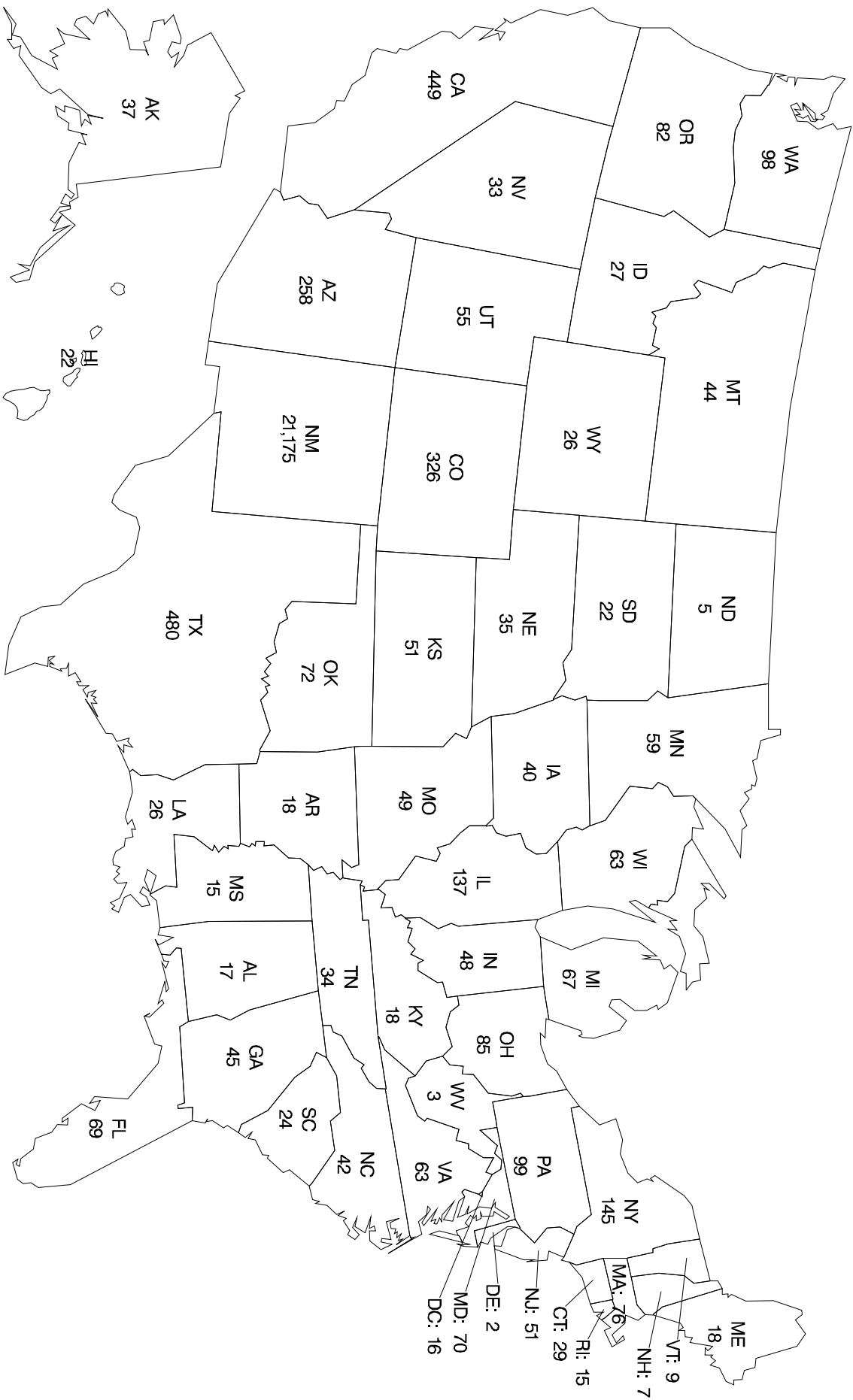
BY *Original Residence – MAIN CAMPUS
