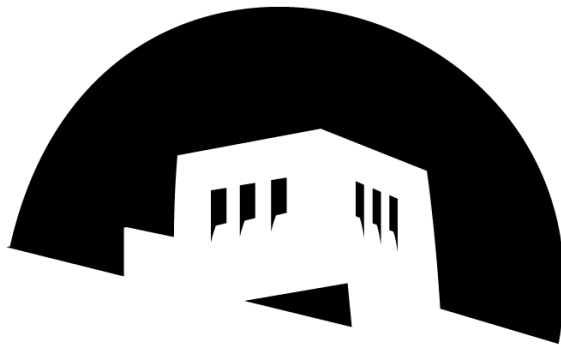

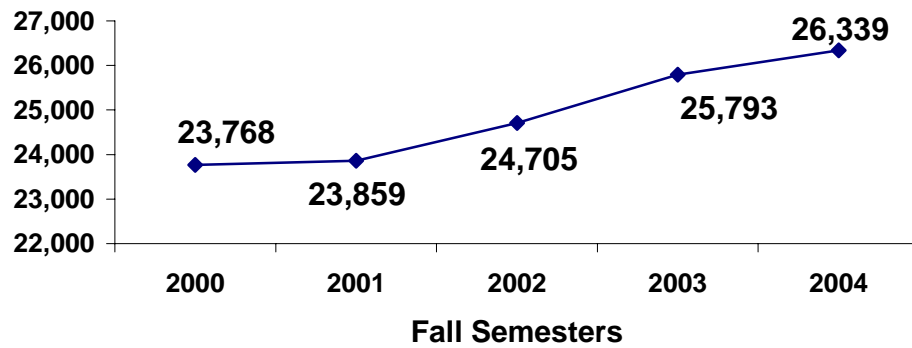

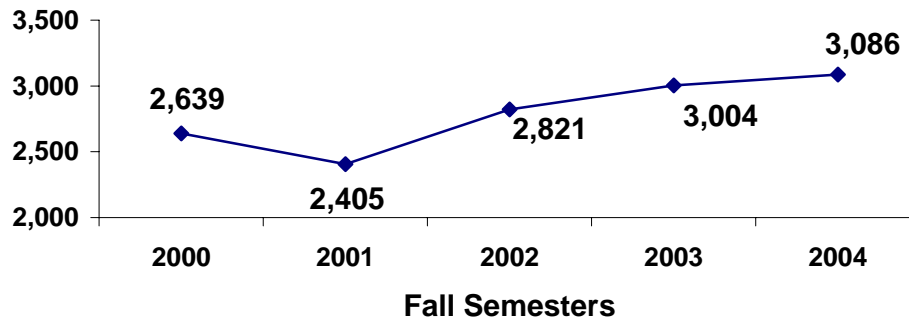
Fall 2004 Official Enrollment Report

Main Campus

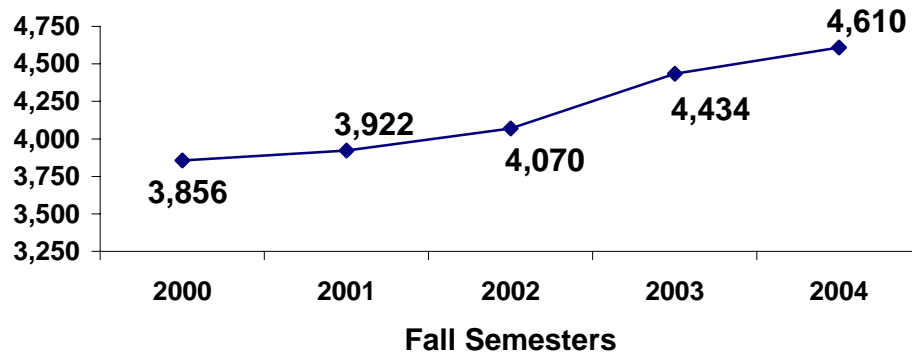
UNM Main Campus Headcount

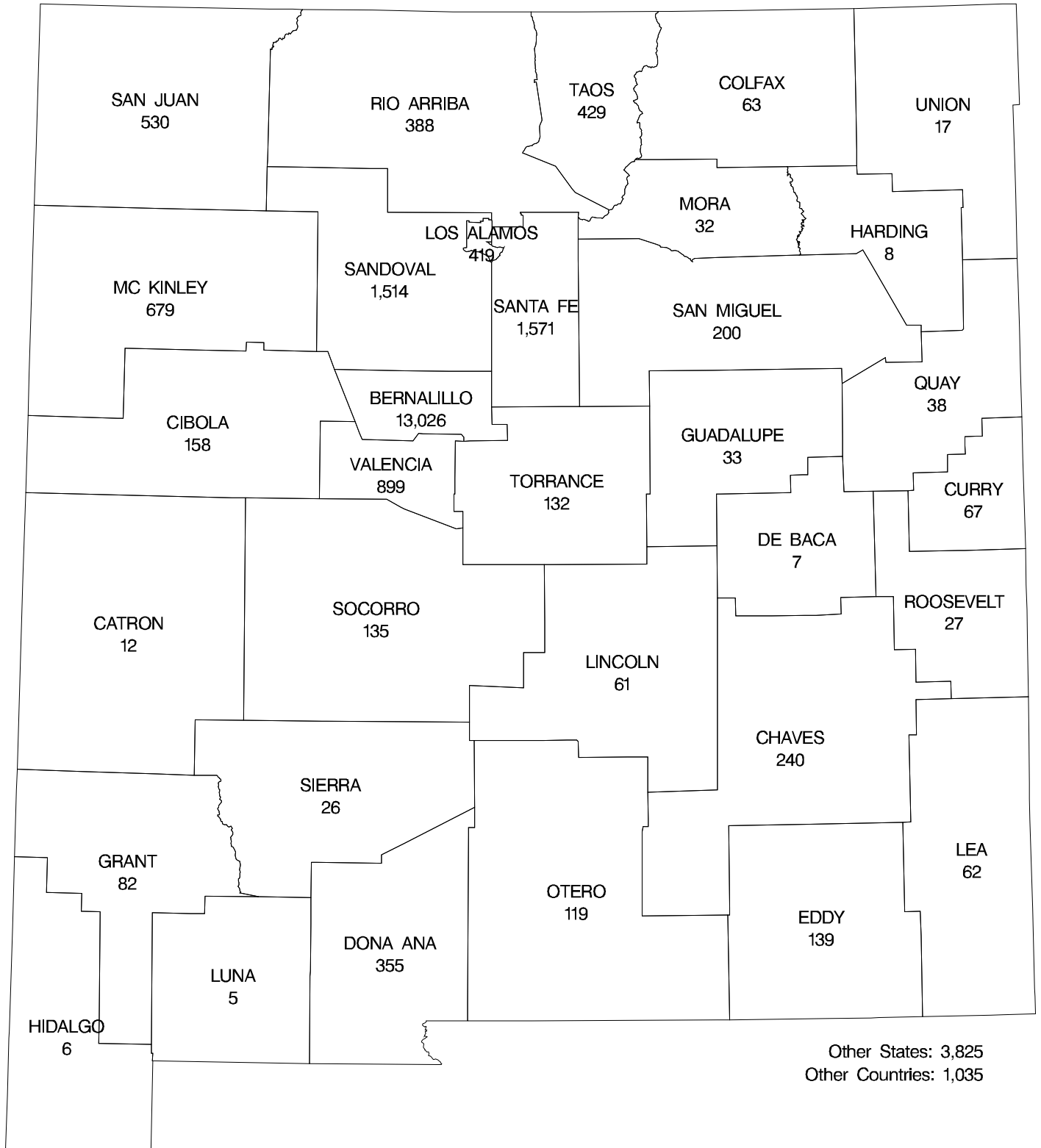

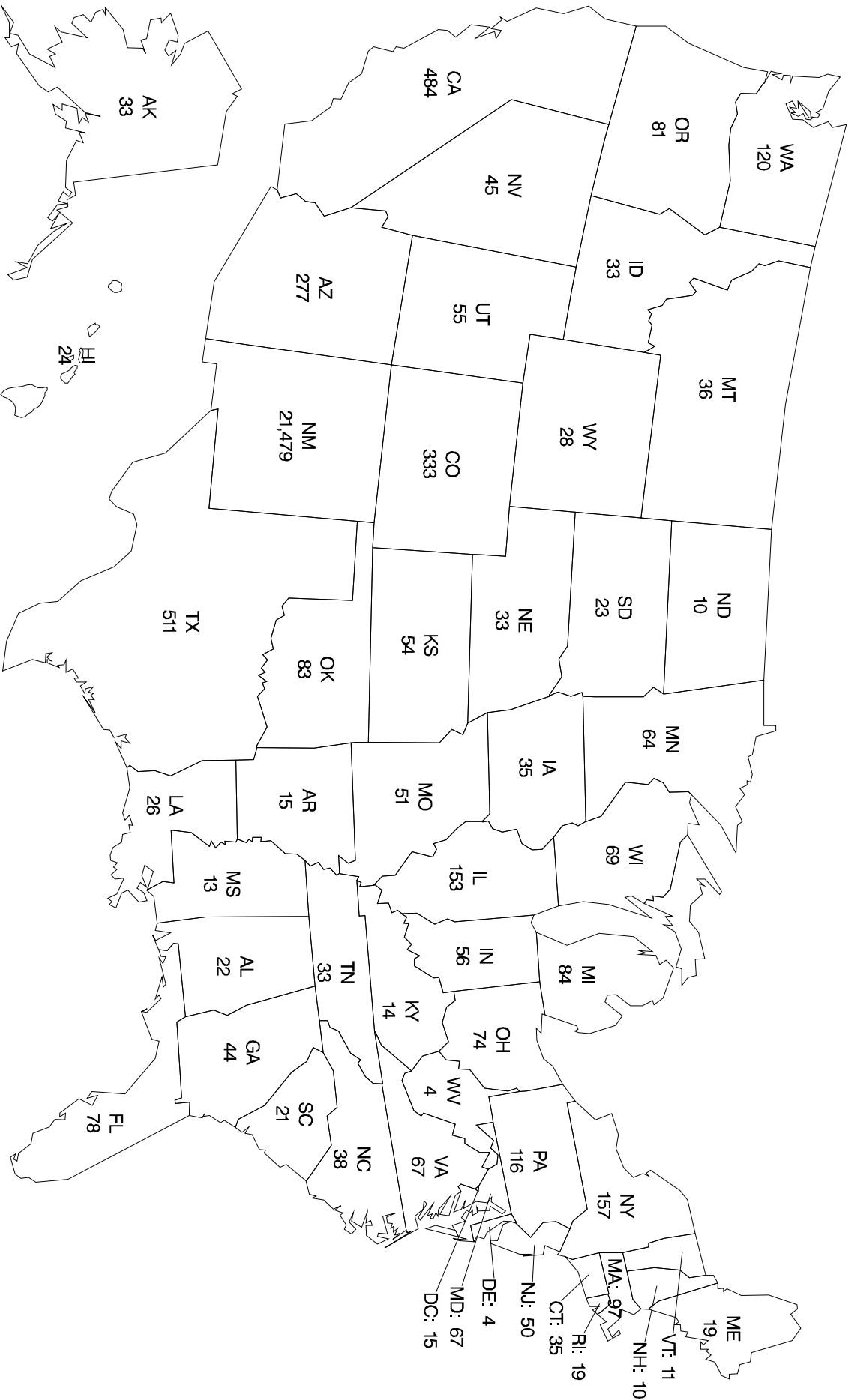
BY *Original Residence – MAIN CAMPUS

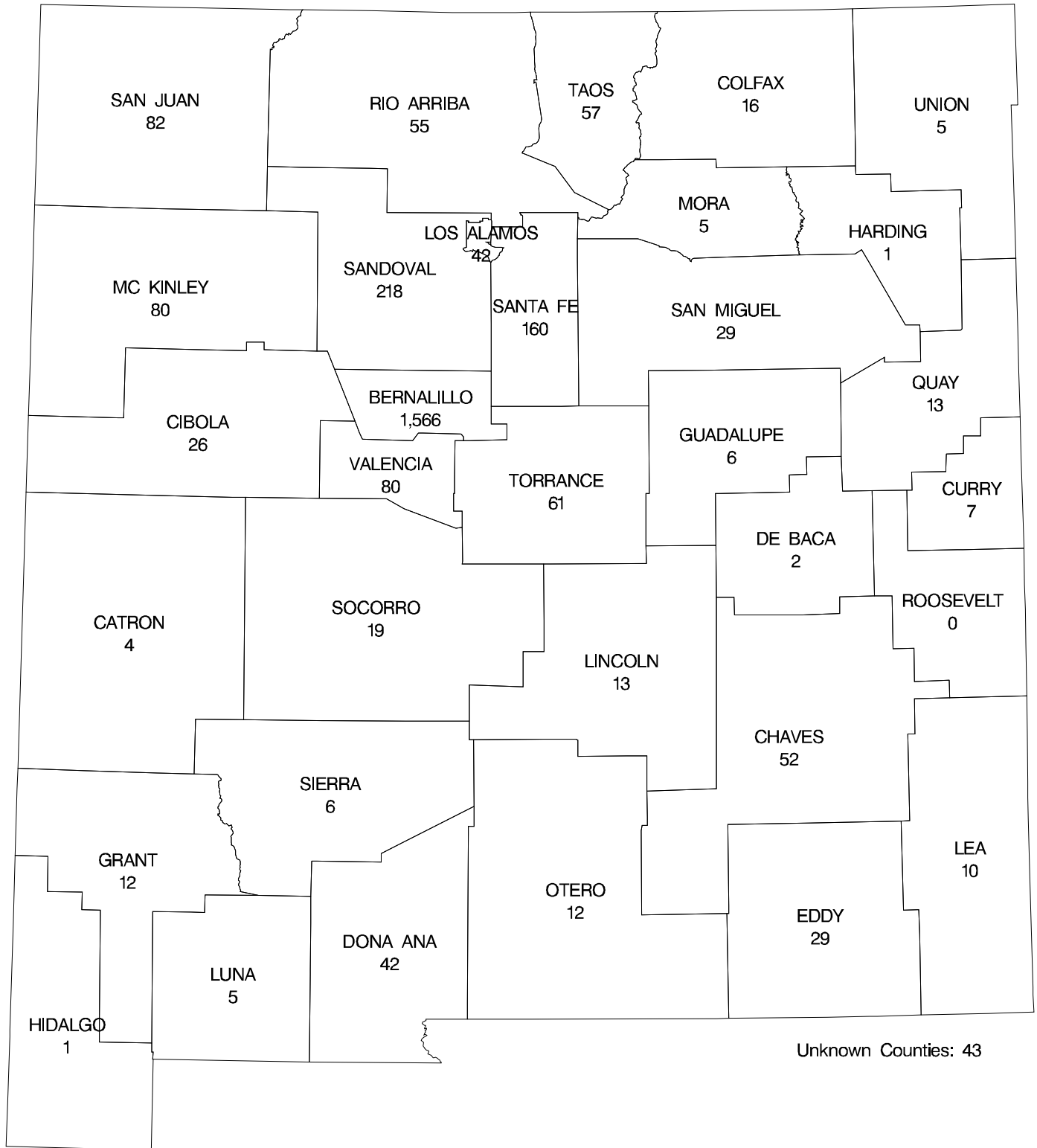
