Upward Bound is a free, year-round college prep program for high school students who are serious about college. The goal of the program is to prepare low-income, first-generation students for success in their college careers.

Students attending Los Lunas High School, Valencia High School, or Belen High School must qualify for selection to the program. Once selected, students remain in the program until their graduation from high school and completion of their first year of college.

#### If you are a student who is:

- Low-income and/or first generation\* college-bound in your family
- In the 9th, 10th, or 11th grade of high school
- In need of academic assistance...*you may qualify!*

#### The Upward Bound Program consists of:

- Supplemental instruction toward preparation for college (Saturday morning instruction)

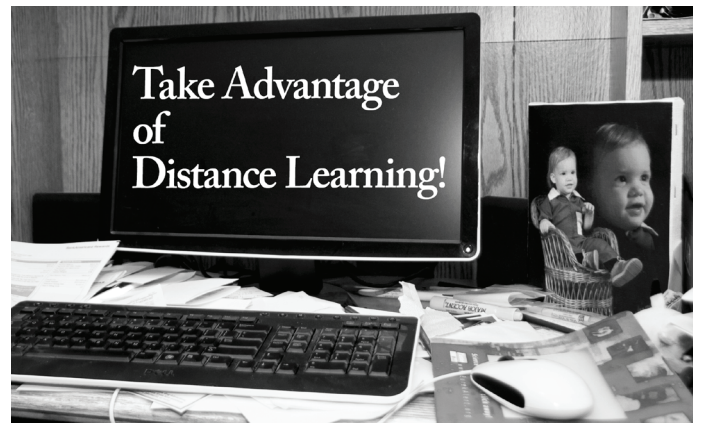
