Workers spend three-fourths of their time on the job communicating, both orally and in writing. Nonetheless, one study (Boice 1990) found that fewer than ten percent of college teachers teach writing intensive courses. When these faculty were asked questions about why they resisted bringing writing into the classroom, the most common responses included:

1. Grading writing assignments requires too much time
2. My classroom time is already full
3. My students will dislike the extra work
4. I am not an expert at teaching writing

The *objective* of this workshop is to help teachers overcome each of these concerns, and to reassure teachers that, "Our Students Can Too Write-And We Can Show Them How."
